

Ohio Society of Health-System Pharmacy (OSHP) Division Day – March 8th, 2024 Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the purpose of Division Day?

Division Day is an opportunity to connect in person with OSHP Members throughout the state and collaborate in person on division related activities. Division day provides collaboration, community, and engagement.

- COLLABORATION -- Bring all divisions together in one place to discuss current plans and brainstorm ideas for the future.
- COMMUNITY -- Foster the OSHP community through opportunities to network with one another.
- ENGAGEMENT-- Encourage & engage learners to invest in the pharmacy profession at large.

2. I am not sure I am a member of a Division. Am I able to attend OSHP Division Day?

YES! An OSHP Membership includes engagement in a Division and Local Area Chapter. If you are not sure if you are a member of a Division (or which one), you can note which one you would like to participate in when you register for the event. OSHP Division Directors will make sure you are then added to their respective groups for engagement after Division Day!

3. Where will the March 8th, 2024 OSHP Division Day be held?

The 3/8/24 OSHP Division Day will be hosted at the OhioHealth Blom Administrative Campus (BAC) located at 3430 OhioHealth Pkwy, Columbus, OH 43202. Thank you to OhioHealth for hosting us!

4. Is there a cost associated with parking at the OhioHealth Blom Administrative Campus (BAC)?

Parking is FREE! Visitor parking is located in the Surface Lot. Please note, garage is badge access only for OhioHealth associates. See the "OhioHealth BAC Visitor Overview" for more information.

5. Is OSHP providing any food or beverages during the event?

OSHP will provide coffee, tea, and a variety of snacks free of charge to attendees.

There are water refill stations throughout the building. To support OhioHealth's sustainability journey, please bring your own water bottle!

Lunch <u>will not</u> be provided free of charge by OSHP for most attendees. PHARMACY TECHNICIANS receive a FREE 6 Month OSHP Membership and lunch at Division Day - Sponsored by Pharmacy Stars! See the available food options in #6-#8.



6. What are the available food options at the OhioHealth Blom Administrative Campus?

The Blue Plate Café is a cafeteria offering pre-packed meals, salad bar, and hot made to order options. They also have a variety of sides, snacks, and bottled beverages are available for purchase.

The recharge, coffee and beverage café located on the second floor serves Starbucks Coffee.

Both locations are cashless with a self-checkout kiosk.

7. Can I bring my own lunch?

YES! There are refrigerators and microwaves on-site if needed. Additionally, plastic cutlery and napkins are available in the Blue Plate Café.

8. Am I able to leave the campus and get food nearby?

YES! There are a number of nearby options available. Some also offer on-line ordering with a pick-up option if you would like to then bring your food back to network during lunch.

External catering is <u>not</u> permitted at the OhioHealth Blom Administrative Campus.

9. Are there any other building amenities?

There is a lactation room available on the first floor. Additionally, there are several community and single stall restrooms throughout the facility. If needed, phone rooms are available to step out and take a private call or meeting.

10. The event is FREE, why do I need to register for the event?

While OSHP Division Day is a free event, registration will help to meet OhioHealth requirements for security of the campus. Additionally, registration helps to ensure we have adequate space and snacks for attendees.



11. I know someone who might be interesting in becoming an OSHP member, can I bring them to Division Day?

YES! Guests of OSHP Members are welcome (i.e. learners, peers, etc) as a means to showcase the value of an OSHP membership. Individuals can join OSHP before, during, or after Division Day. Membership will be required to continue engagement beyond Division Day or process CE if offered.
